

OES Upper School Online Publication Permission Form

Dear Parent/Guardian:

Some OES Upper School courses offer students the opportunity to publish their work on the public OES web site. These publications may include student research data and writing, literary stories, poems, artwork, group photographs and other materials. In addition to providing a valuable opportunity for students to share their work with peers, some colleges review online student work as part of the admissions process.

The standard policy at OES is that full student names cannot be shown on the public web site (only the first initial of the last name is used). By choice, some students may want their full names published with their work, and some colleges expect to see full names as evidence of attribution.

In order to honor the request of some students and families to have full accreditation published online, we offer the following choices:

- If you want the standard OES policy to continue to apply to your son/daughter's online work (no full names: first name and first initial of last name), please check here.
- If you would like your son/daughter to be able to publish work online with his/her full name, but NOT his or her photograph, please check here.
- If you would like your son/daughter to be able to publish work online with his/her full name and photograph, please check here.
