The School

Oregon Episcopal School (OES) is an independent coeducational day-boarding school located in Portland, OR. Founded as St. Helens Hall in 1869, the School currently enrolls 840 students in pre-kindergarten through grade 12. The Position

The Lower School Math Specialist is part of a program that addresses support and enrichment for students at Oregon Episcopal School implementing a system that proactively engages students, families, faculty and staff and outside providers in an effort to support students' mathematical strengths and address their academic needs.

Responsibilities include:

- Manage math enrichment and support in the Learning Center
- Teach math in Building Group Leader's classrooms
- Analyze the math needs of Lower School sub-groups including grade levels, classes and students with specific needs
- Support professional development for faculty and staff on constructivist math instruction
- Consult with students, faculty and parents on math strengths, challenges and accommodations
- Review best practice math resources, including online computational and conceptual possibilities, to supplement current core math curriculum
- Raise parent awareness about approaches to math education
- Collaborate with the student support team including weekly student support meetings
- Collaborate on math class placement of students moving up to Middle School
- Collaborate with admissions committee as necessary

Qualifications

Candidates for this position should have at least 5 years experience in math instruction in a school setting, including experience working with faculty and families. Candidates should hold an advanced degree in an applicable field and have professional understanding of math instruction spanning early childhood to adolescence.
