

## **Summer Aardvark Community Agreements**

Health authorities have reiterated throughout the COVID-19 global pandemic that the health of every community depends on the actions of all individuals within that community. We recognize that the safety of our community is also dependent on a <u>layered approach</u> with a variety of risk mitigation efforts. As we host in-person summer camps, we ask that students and families at OES commit to the following:

Read the <u>COVID-19 OES Understanding of Risks</u> .
Monitor my student's health and complete the OES health screening survey each morning before leaving home.
Keep my student home if they or any household member has one or more <u>symptoms of COVID-19</u> , or if my student has been exposed to someone with a diagnosed or presumptive case of COVID-19.
Contact <u>Summer at OES</u> immediately if a student or household pod member is diagnosed with COVID-19.
Prepare by having my student equipped with two clean, multi-layered cloth <u>face</u> <u>coverings</u> or surgical masks when they are on campus.
Observe all health/safety protocols while on campus, including frequent hand washing, wearing a mask indoors and outdoors unless instructed otherwise by a teacher, and maintaining a distance from others of at least six feet whenever possible.
Alert an OES employee if sickness occurs while on campus and proceed immediately to the isolation room. Parents will be required to pick up students promptly.
<u>Avoid non-essential travel</u> , and adhere to OES's <u>requirements for post-travel quarantine</u> if my student does travel.
Limit our <u>household exposure</u> by minimizing the indoor social interactions of each household member to a small group of people.
Avoid social indoor gatherings and crowds, follow OHA guidelines whenever possible.
Adhere to recommended health and safety guidelines including masks and physical distancing when interacting with people outside of our household bubble.
Understand that if we do not uphold these commitments, my student(s) may not be allowed on campus for a period of time as determined by the OES administration.
Understand that these protocols may change as health experts' guidance about preventing the spread of COVID-19 evolves.
